Bachelor's and Master's Degree Programmes

The aim of the European academic structure is to improve comparability and recognition of degrees within Europe. After completing an 'A' level equivalent, passing the university entrance examination or vocational matriculation examination, the three-year bachelor's programme ends with a first academic degree. The two-year master's programme builds on the foundation of the first academic degree and deepens the practical professional training at university level. Graduates who have successfully completed a master's programme are entitled to participate in university doctoral programmes.

Programme Structure and Curriculum

Classes are held in the form of lectures, tutorials and workshops. Students attend the modules listed below and complete the programme by passing a final exam.
